**Prayer of Confession**

L: Holy and Triune God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, We come before You confessing that we have not loved You with our whole heart, mind, soul, and strength.

**P: Father, You created us in Your image, yet we often fail to honor You as our Creator and Lord. We have taken Your gifts for granted and trusted in ourselves more than in You.**

L: Jesus Christ, You came among us in love and grace, yet we have

not always followed Your example. We have failed to love our neighbors, to forgive as we have been forgiven, and to share Your good news with the world.

**P: Holy Spirit, You dwell within us and guide us in truth, yet we have resisted Your leading. We have ignored Your promptings, quenched Your fire, and chosen our own way instead of Yours.**

L: Forgive us, O God. Renew us by Your mercy. Restore us through Your grace. Transform us by Your Spirit.

**ALL: Draw us deeper into the life of Your love, that we may reflect Your goodness in all we say and do. We ask this in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.**
