Blessing of the Animals June 28 at 1pm Outside Chapel

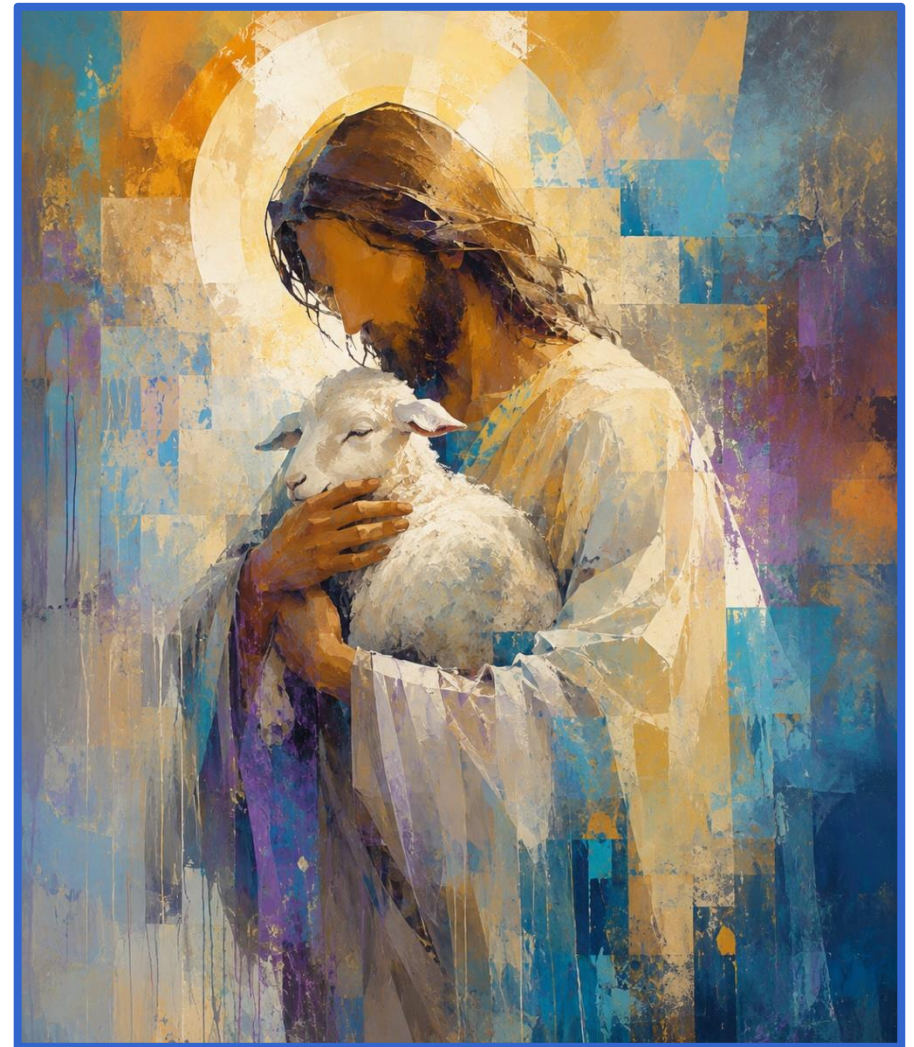
