Children's Sermon

Prayer of Confession (based on Matthew 9 and Ephesians 2)

Leader: Let us pray...Merciful God, You have created us in Christ Jesus for good works, and You have called us to join in Your mission of love and compassion.

**People: Yet we confess that we often fail to see the crowds as Jesus saw them. Instead of being moved with compassion, we can become distracted, indifferent, or focused only on ourselves.**

L: Forgive us when we overlook those who are hurting, lonely, lost, or burdened.

**P: Forgive us when we hesitate to serve, when we ignore opportunities to share Your love, or when we doubt that You can use us for Your purposes.**

L: You have made us Your workmanship and prepared good works for us to do, yet we often resist Your calling.

**P: We confess our fear, our busyness, and our lack of trust.**

L: Open our eyes to see the needs around us. Fill our hearts with the compassion of Christ.

**ALL: Empower us by Your Spirit to be faithful workers in Your harvest, serving others with humility, kindness, and love. Through Jesus Christ our Lord, we pray. Amen.**

Leader: Hear the good news! God is rich in mercy and great in love. We are saved by grace through faith—not by our own works, but by the gift of God.

**People: Thanks be to God for His amazing grace!**

Leader: In Jesus Christ, our sins are forgiven, our lives are made new, and we are restored to God's purpose for us. We are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to walk in the good works He has prepared for us.

**People: We receive God's forgiveness with grateful hearts.**

Leader: Therefore, be at peace. In the name of Jesus Christ, you are forgiven and loved.

**ALL: In the name of Jesus Christ, we are forgiven. Thanks be to God! Amen.**

Blessing of the Animals June 28 at 1pm Outside Chapel

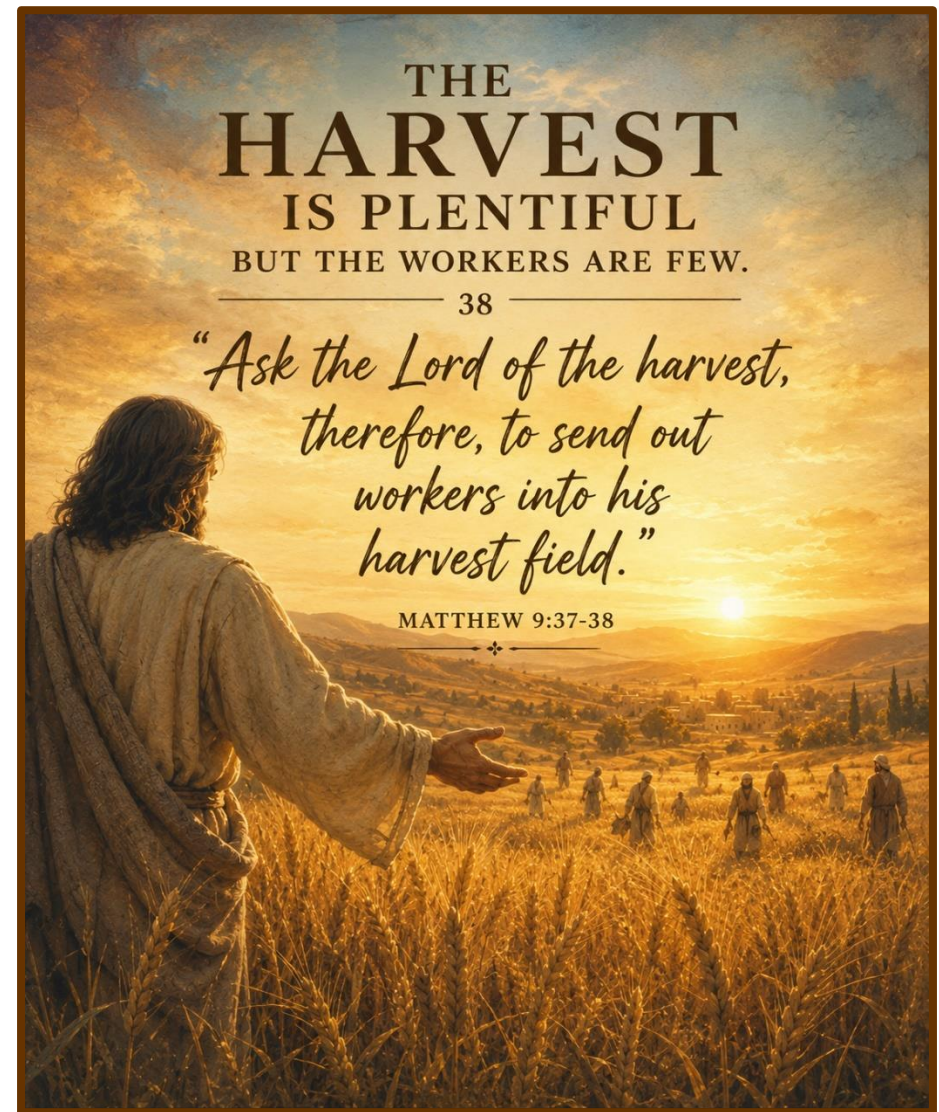
